### **†Prayer of Confession** (*Praying first in silent confession*)

### **†Words of Assurance**

One: Our wise God knows that we see only through a mirror dimly, but one day we will see face to face. Our Wise God knows that we know only in part, until that day we know in full the depth of God's love. Our Wise God forgives us, calls us to open our minds to new understanding, and our hearts to love all of God's people. Come, know that you are forgiven, and set your minds on what God desires for you, and know the fullness of God's love now.
