Sunday School, Grades 1-6 Meets for Lesson #2 on Sunday, Oct. 17th

An Illustrated Invitation: Joining God at Work in the World: Lesson: God's Love for Hagar & Ishmael

All youth grades 1-6 are invited to begin Sunday school on the 3rd Sunday of the month immediately following the Children's Message. The curriculum highlights biblical stories of joining God at work in the world from the Hebrew Scriptures and the New Testament. It is designed to draw children ages preschool to fifth grade into conversation with biblical stories, showing them what God is doing, and inviting them to consider how to join in that work. Each lesson highlights a particular biblical story and provides opportunities to focus on hearing and reflecting on the story with open-ended questions, creating meaningful art, sharing in an interactive activity based on the story, and providing an opportunity to share the word of God.
